











Palladium USA with Planet Smart City on Thursday celebrated the groundbreaking for The District in Little Elm, a four-story complex that will include 324 dwelling units with 20,000 square feet of new retail space at Main Street and West Eldorado Parkway in the Town of Little Elm, Texas. The \$50 million project, which has been in the works since 2013, will also include such amenities as a parking garage, a pedestrian bridge, two resort-style pools, a dog park, trails and a fitness center. Denton County Judge Andy Eads welcomed the development which sits across the street from Palladium USA's first development in Little Elm known as the Village at Lakefront. Palladium USA also contributed funds to complete an adjacent park known as The Lawn.
